



Standard Operating Procedure for Archery and Khuru

The following procedures/conditions must be followed for Archery and Khuru under the New Normal:

1. Team captains/coordinators shall submit the list of players with details (Name, CID No, Contact No. and Place of Residence) atleast one day before the game.
2. Players shall be strictly confined to the residents of Samtse Dzongkhag. People who have come from Red Zone areas and inviting teams from another Dzongkhags/Thromde shall not be allowed.
3. Member Secretary to Samtse Archery Association (SAA) shall maintain proper list and record of the causal players on daily basis.
4. Players with fever and flu-like symptoms shall not be allowed to enter the range and participate in the game. SAA and respective team captains/coordinators shall be responsible to ensure that no players with the above symptoms participate in the game.
5. All players must undergo thermal scanning at entry gate. The SAA shall be responsible for providing the thermal scanning facility and ensuring its effective implementation.
6. All players must mandatorily use Druk Trace App before entering the range.
7. All players must mandatorily wash hand before entry and exit from the archery range. SAA shall ensure adequate hand washing facilities in place at strategic locations.
8. All players shall wear face mask during the time of entry and after the match.
9. All players shall maintain physical distance (1 meter) before match/half time break/after match.
10. No spectators shall be allowed.
11. The timing for the games shall be from 6.00 AM to 8.00 PM
12. The number of players allowed shall be limited to 10 players only.
13. Online payment system is recommended for payment of fees.
14. SAA shall sanitize and disinfect the public toilet, ball and player resting chairs.
15. SDSA and SAA shall take full responsibility & accountability in ensuring the compliance of the above procedure and conditions.
16. The respective team captains/coordinators shall ensure full compliance and adherence to the safety protocols.

While getting the relaxation to enjoy Archery and Khuru, all players must know that Samtse Dzongkhag is a high-risk area unlike other Dzongkhag/Thromdey area.

Therefore, it is the sole responsibility of every players to strictly observe the mandatory health safety protocols and the conditions specified in the SOP.
